With organist Oliver Lallemand - Olly will be improvising in his unique jazz style at the organ, as well as accompanying Leonard Bernstein's 'Chichester Psalms', which were written for the Three Choirs' Festival in 1965. The Dean of Chichester, Walter Hussey, famously commissioned Bernstein with the words: "I hope there will be a little of West Side Story in the Psalms"; in the event Hussey got even more than he had bargained for. The choir will also sing resonant Russian Orthodox music by Rachmaninov and Kedrov, as well as muscular Renaissance music by Dufay and Palestrina.
